

Managing Cookies

If your browser is set to delete your cookies at certain time intervals or you manually delete your browsing history, try the steps listed below. These steps should help save you from being prompted to complete the security code each time you login to your online banking.

Adjusting Cookie Permissions in Different Browsers

CHROME:

1. Click the **Menu icon** on the right side of the browser toolbar.
2. Select **Settings (Preferences** on Mac and Linux; **Settings** on a Chromebook).
3. Click the **Show advanced settings** tab.
4. Click **Content settings** in the "Privacy" section.
5. Click the **Cookies** tab in the Content Settings dialog that appears:

Make exceptions for cookies from specific websites or domains

To control how cookies should be handled for a few specific sites or domains, click **Manage exceptions**.

To add a rule in the Cookie and Site Data Exceptions dialog that appears, follow these steps:

1. Click the field and enter the domain name for which you want to create an exception.
 - To create exceptions for an entire domain, insert [*****.] before the domain name (e.g. [*****.]google.com).
 - Type in "**[*]online.drummondbank.com**", without the quotes.
2. Use the menu to choose whether the site can set cookies. If you select **Clear on exit**, its cookies are deleted every time you close your browser.

You can also edit or remove exceptions using this dialog.

INTERNET EXPLORER 7, 8 & 9:

1. Click the Tools button, and then click Internet Options.
2. Click the Privacy tab, and then move the slider to a position between the top and bottom so you are not blocking or allowing all cookies.
3. Click **Sites**.
4. In the Address of website box, type a website address, and then **Allow**.
 - As you type, a list of web pages that you have already visited will be displayed. You can click an item in the list and it will be displayed in the Address of website box or
 - Type in - "**http://www.online.drummondbank.com**" without the quotes
5. When you are finished, click **OK**.
6. Then click **OK**.

FIREFOX:

1. Click the **Firefox menu** in the top left corner, and then click **Options**.
2. Click the **Privacy** icon
3. Under History, Set "Firefox will:" to "Use Custom settings for history".
4. Next to "Accept cookies from sites", click "**Exceptions**"
5. In the "Address of the web site:" enter "**online.drummondbank.com**" (without quotes).
6. Click **Allow**.
7. Click **Close**.
8. Click **OK**.
